


Tax Collection News

Second, the treasurer will be utilizing the window at the office for in person payments for a more sanitary exchange. Third, you can also make your payments online through BS&A with a credit card for a small convenience fee. This option eliminates the worry of whether or not your payment has been received. At that point we encourage all residents to utilize the curbside service offered through our garbage carrier, North Country Disposal.
