Zoning Ordinance Update-

Expected to be discussed are: -Permanent and seasonal dwelling mixes on lakefront properties -Short term rental regulations

Lundin Closure planning for Humboldt Mill-The company has hired planning consultants to prepare plans for the ultimate closure of their processing plant in Humboldt.

Recreation Plan 5 Year Update-

Recreation Plans are required to leverage State and Federal funds for upgrades or development of new Township Recreational facilities. Recent contributions by Lundin Mining will also help to accomplish the mission in providing for new recreational opportunities. A few prominent aspects expected to be discussed are: -Trail development, including the Iron Ore Heritage Trail & Republic Mine Wetlands project.

-There is now a Foot Care Clinic held at the hall, the second Thursday of the month. Please call for more information.



There is also a newly formed Medical First Responder Authority that joins multiple neighboring Townships. It is a great opportunity to provide a greatly needed service in our West end area. Once again, the Board feels the need to highlight some problems within the Township. There is still the ongoing issue of blight throughout the entire Township. We are asking everyone to please clean-up any problem areas that violate our Zoning Ordinance. We will be sending out violation letters when we get complaints. There also seems to be increasing vandalism on Township property There are signs of graffiti, as well as several vehicle tracks on multiple park areas. PLEASE be respectful and proud of where we live and treat all property responsibly! The Board has been working hard to make the area beautiful and provide enjoyment for everyone. One last issue pertains to the Michigan Dog Leash Law. Required per MCL 287.262 no dog owner is allowed to have his or her dog stray in public unless leashed properly. We have had a few complaints of loose dogs chasing and nipping at people walking and biking. When we receive these calls, we will be calling the police to have the incident investigated. Pets are also not allowed in the park. Please obey the law and contain your pets for everyone's safety!
